

# DB2 Server Setup Instructions



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## Purpose

This document describes the server setup needed to install the DB2 product. You only need to complete these instructions if you are installing the DB2 product.

## Before You Begin

Make sure you have completed the common setup instructions. You must complete these steps before you can install DB2.

## Install the DB2 Installation Program

Insert the ePower CD in your CD drive. Choose Start – Run and then browse. Browse to your CD drive and double click the DB2 folder. Double click the SETUP.EXE program. Choose OK to begin the installation.

### ***Setup must update your system:***

You may receive a message that your system files are out of date and must be replaced. Choose yes and let setup replace these files. You must re-boot and then start the setup again.

### ***Installing the program:***

Accept the defaults and let the installation program install the files. These files are small and are only needed to begin the DB2 installation. Later you can choose the main DB2 drive where larger files will be installed.

## Start the server installation

When setup completes, choose Start – Programs – OPSSoftware – DB2 Server Installation to begin the installation.

Click Next to begin the DB2 installation.

When DB2 server installation requests the drive containing the DB2 installation files, use the drop down box to select your CD drive containing the ePower CD and then click next.

Next you will select the drive to install the DB2 files. If you will be installing wholesaler eContent, make sure the drive you select has 1 gigabyte free to contain all the images and data from your wholesaler. Click next to continue.

The final screen appears before files will be copied. Click next to start the file copy from the CD to the selected installation drive.

## Finishing the installation

After the copying of files completes, click the finish button to complete the DB2 server installation. You must now re-boot your server for the changes to take effect.

When you re-boot your server, DB2 will automatically start. If asked to update databases, always choose yes.
